





# LEVERAGING LESSONS FROM COVID RESPONSE TO IMPROVE FUTURE PREPAREDNESS AND SPEED OF RESPONSE









Personnel & Partnerships



- Establish a dedicated team of highly skilled personnel to enable surge and meet crisis
- Maintain and build trusted, critical partnerships that can be leveraged in time of need



Support to Joint Force Readiness



- Build supply chain resilience to insulate Joint Force readiness against potential interruptions
- Maintain clear understanding of global supply chain vulnerabilities and potential impacts



Rapid Response Acquisitions



- Leverage rapid viable awards, existing contracting mechanisms, and cross-functional relationships to expedite access to non-traditional industry partners
- Maintain in-depth understanding of what incentivizes non-traditional industry partners in negotiations
- Facilitate rapid requirement identification and finalization, and subsequent statement of work generation
- Requires innovative and continuous market research along with funding and decisional flexibility to enable rapid contracting approaches (sole source and competitive)
- Leverage all available award instruments, legal authorities and soliciting methods
- Leverage all market research for justification and approval to execute rapid contracting strategies
- Require direct Senior Leader involvement in discussions to provide real-time acquisition strategy guidance to speed processes, focus documentation, and the enterprise on expectations/outcomes
- Require direct involvement of program managers, legal counsel, contracting representatives, and performers from requirement generation through award


