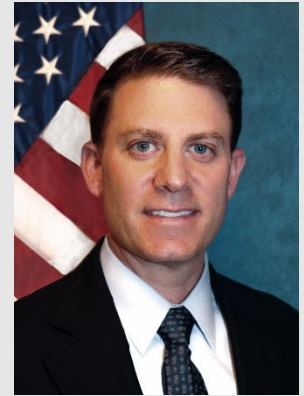
Mr. Kyle L. Perkins

Mr. Kyle Perkins serves as the Acting Deputy Joint Program Executive Officer (DJPEO) to the Joint Program Executive Office for Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear Defense (JPEO-CBRND). In this capacity he manages the JPEO-CBRND's Staff and assists the JPEO and DPEOs by providing oversight to the development, training, and fielding activities across the organization's six Joint Project Management/Lead offices. Having spent his career working for organizations within Command, Control, Communications, Computers, Cyber, Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (C5ISR), he has a unique blend of acquisition, technical, and business expertise suited for large complex acquisition programs.

To support the JPEO's mission, Mr. Perkins engages internally across a diverse set of Project Managers, as well as externally with various elements within the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Acquisition Logistics and Technology (ASA ALT), Headquarter Department of the Army (HQDA) Staff, Department of Defense, Industry, and International Partners.

Mr. Perkins has held numerous management positions within both PEO IEW&S and PEO Command Control and Communications (C3T), where he led strategic priorities supporting ASA(ALT) and the Army. He was the Business Financial Manager for Project Manager Mission Command (PM MC), managing the organizations financial, contractual, and programmatic requirements, which spanned multiple Product Managers (PdMs). In addition, he led three technical efforts, including Command Post Computing Environment (CP CE), Tactical Digital Media (TMD), and Mission Command Cyber. These efforts focused on modernizing tactical operating systems and Mission Command applications in support of maneuver and field artillery forces, developing and fielding a diverse set of capabilities to enable the net centric processing and dissemination of visual information to conduct inform and influence operations, and integrating defensive cyber capabilities into tactical architectures to increase a commander's situational understanding.

Mr. Perkins holds a Bachelor's of Science in Business Administration and Marketing with a concentration in Entrepreneurship from Rider University and a Master's of Science in Program Management of the Naval Post Graduate School. He is an Acquisition Corps Member who is certified as a Level III Acquisition Professional in Business, Cost Estimating, and Financial Management (BCFM), and Program Management. He is a graduate of the Defense Systems Management College PMT 401 Program Managers Course, the Aberdeen Proving Ground (APG) Senior Leader Cohort, the Office of Personnel Management's Federal Internal Coach Training Program (FICTP), and is a certified professional coach through the International Coach Federation (ICF).
